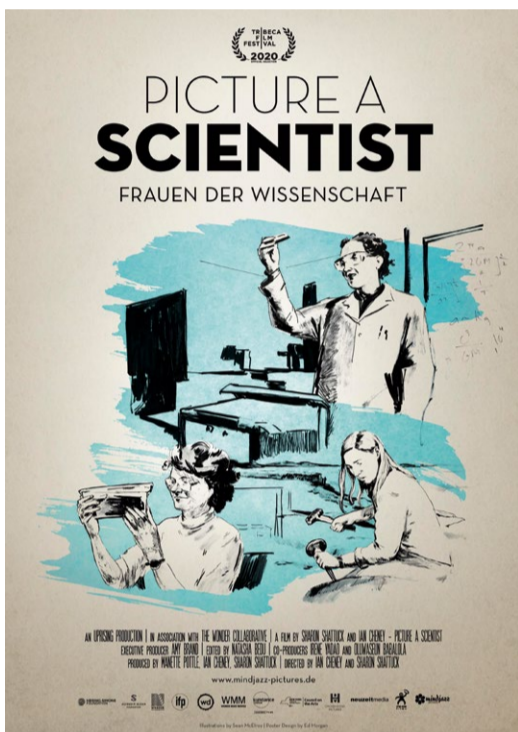


Picture a Scientist: Screening and Panel Discussion
